

*Mark’s Sweeping Summary
of Jesus’ Ministry*
Mark 3:7-19

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Questions for study and discussion:

1. Why does Jesus withdraw from the crowds in verse 7, and what does this reveal about His priorities or strategy?

2. What does the diversity of regions listed in verse 8 (e.g., Judea, Idumea, Tyre, Sidon) suggest about the scope of Jesus’ influence and mission?

3.How does the naming of Judas Iscariot as the betrayer (v.19) affect our understanding of Jesus’ foreknowledge and purpose in choosing him?

4. What does this passage teach us about the balance between public ministry and private discipleship?

5. In what ways are we called to “be with Him” (v.14) before being sent out? How does this shape our view of discipleship?

6. What does it mean to be “appointed” by Jesus today? How do we discern our calling in light of this passage

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
