Questions for Dig Deeper:

1. vv.1-2 - Why were the people “astonished” at Jesus’ teaching, and what does their reaction reveal about spiritual blindness?
2. v. 3 - How does the crowd’s question, “Is this not the carpenter...?” expose the danger of reducing Jesus to human categories?
3. v. 3 - What does their offense at Jesus teach us about the human heart’s resistance to divine authority?
4. v. 4 - Why does Jesus say, “A prophet is not without honor except in his own country...” and how does this principle still operate today?
5. v. 5 - What does it mean that Jesus “could do no mighty work there,” and how does this relate to the relationship between faith and God’s activity?
6. v. 6 - Why did Jesus “marvel because of their unbelief,” and what does this tell us about the seriousness of rejecting truth?
7. vv. 5-6 - How does Jesus’ response-continuing to teach in surrounding villages-model perseverance in ministry despite rejection?
